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Data

- In 2013 in Israel:
277 people were killed in car accidents
62 people were killed in work accidents
Dozens died as a result of other types of accidents

Damages Caused to the Estate

Damages Caused to the Dependents

- Loss of support
- Loss of services
- Burial expenses



Deduction of Profits
